Changes to Security Rules At UK Airports

Thursday 3 January 2008

The Department for Transport has approved new security arrangements at a number of airports in the UK. This means that at these airports the restriction previously imposed limiting hand baggage to one item per person will no longer apply with effect from 7 January 2008. However, please remember that this **does not** affect airlines' own rules on items that can be taken on board aircraft.

The security rule relating to the carriage of liquids in hand baggage has not changed:
